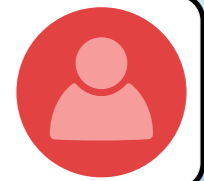

### Say It

**What is the problem or challenge?**

- Who is involved?
- When is it happening?
- Where is it happening?

### Know Your Options

**What are your choices and the possible consequences?**

- What are the positive and negative consequences of each choice?
- Why is it difficult to make a decision?

### In Response

**Do what you think is right to keep yourself safe and healthy.**

Use the information and facts gathered.

### Look Back and Learn

**How did it work out?**

- What have you learned?
- Would you make the same decision again?
